Welcome to My-LEARN

MY-LEARN is the Learning Management System (LMS) used by Toyota Finance Australia Limited (TFAL).

MY-LEARN has been deployed to support the learning and development of TFAL representatives with the dealership network as well as TFAL employees.

MY-LEARN is easy to use and is accessible from any computer with an Internet connection and an up to date web browser.

You can access MY-LEARN at any time at your convenience, from work or from home.



PASSWORDS & SECURITY

All MY-LEARN accounts are password protected.

Whilst you're online using MY-LEARN you are protected by a SSL (HTTPS) secure connection which is the same level used for Internet banking.

If you've forgotten your password details you can use the **Lost Password** link on the login screen to request a new password.

Simply enter your username and a new password will be sent to your email address.

You will be prompted to set a new password when you next log in.





YOUR MY-LEARN ACCOUNT

TFAL DEALERSHIP NETWORK

Each dealership staff member that requires access to TFAL systems must self-register within the MY-LEARN system.

If you have already completed selfregistration and have been confirmed by TFAL Administrators you will have received a welcome email including your login details.

If you have not yet registered, click the **Register** button in the login screen and follow the prompts.

TFAL EMPLOYEES

TFAL employees will be created automatically in the system. There is no need to self-register.

If you have an account within the TFAL Corporate Directory you will have an account within MY-LEARN.

A welcome email will have been sent to your email including your log in details.





TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

MY-LEARN is a hosted web application so no software downloads are required.

You can access the MY-LEARN from any computer that has an up to date web browser and an internet connection.

MINIMUM SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS?

To run MY-LEARN you will need:

- An Internet connection (preferably a broadband connection)
- A web browser We'd recommend Internet Explorer 8+ for Windows or Safari for Macs. MY-LEARN will however also run on Firefox and Chrome
- JavaScript and Cookies enabled
- Flash Player 10+ installed (for launching online content)
- Browser pop-up blocker disabled. If this is not possible refer to the section on adding MY-LEARN as a trusted site on page 3.



Whilst not a requirement MY-LEARN is best viewed using a minimum screen resolution of 1024x768.



POP-UP BLOCKERS

SAFARI ON A MAC

VERSION 5.X AND ABOVE
